CONTRACT CORNER

When school districts make cuts for the following year, teachers worry and questions pop up. Your Member Rights Reps can help answer some of these for you, so note their phone numbers printed here in the Voice. In the spring we will have some helpful information put together for teachers/members who do not have continuing contract status and are losing their jobs. We will hold a meeting for you, give out printed information and address common concerns. For teachers with continuing contract status in 622. if you think you will lose your position and not be able to bid into another, please take time to read about Unrequested Leaves of Absence on pages 27 and 28 of your contract. This section covers your rights, also set out in Mn. state statute. For any teacher who isn't sure if he/she will have continuing contract rights or just needs information about it, feel free to phone your M.R. Rep to confidentially clarify your status. There are some gray areas, teachers don't always agree with their districts and you owe it to yourself to know.




