Contract Corner

Spring is the Time to Renew Your License

Did you mean to renew your teaching license this school year? There's not much time left. Not sure of when your license expires? Find out at <u>https://public.education.mn.gov/</u> LicenseLookup/educator

Keep your credit hours up to date and renew your license as soon as possible. You may complete the renewal paperwork at <u>http://nspmoea.org/</u> as early as the fall of the year before your license expires. That means if your license expires in 2024 you may do this now, and this **must** be done before one of the remaining 2024 relicensure committee meetings: March 21, April 24, May 30. Once the relicensure committee approves your application you must submit payment to the State of Minnesota.

The stakes are extremely high if your license is not fully approved on time. The language quoted below is from the contract, and it means that you could lose pay or lose your job:

"Failure to have a fully approved license identified by the Department of Education website by the first duty day will result in the teacher being placed on an unpaid leave of absence until such time they obtain a fully approved license by the Department of Education.

Failure by the teacher to obtain a fully approved license by the Minnesota Department of Education within 90 days of the license expiration date shall be considered as deemed to have resigned and the employment of the teacher shall be terminated."
